2. BC & RM reported back about a Community Planning meeting they attended on the 19th November where the following matters were raised concerning the ERC Cut Back on Expenditure. The proposals included:
 - a) A reduction in the number of Wardens from 20 to 16, and reducing the coverage from 24 hours to 16 hours.
 - b) Stopping the funding for the Area Forum
 - c) Reducing the community grant funding.
 - d) Reducing the amount of Youth Work
 - e) Ceasing the CCTV rapid response car scheme
 - f) The closure of the Barrhead Recycling Plant
 - g) The stopping of the Mr Dig-It programme

GK offered to draft a reply of our concerns concerning the CC Review to be discussed at a meeting to be arranged for December
