The police then gave their report on local crime and issues from 9th February 2019 until 7th March 2019. They then outlined the number of reported incidents for the four areas highlighted as being key local concerns. These are Housebreakings (4 reported), Anti-social Behaviour (4 reported), Violent Crime (1 reported) and Drug Dealing (3 reported).
