7	Matters Arising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Events / Projects for 2019</u> – RL has drawn up a list of ideas for the UCC for 2019, these are listed below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Village Archive Digitisation – 2 roller cabinets in the library are full of old village photos and text information. Proposal to apply for grant to get these archives professionally digitised. ○ Community Event – Idea to create a community event / exhibition along with the archive project. ○ Uplawmoor Does Christmas 2019 – Expand the event to include more of the village groups. ○ Uplawmoor Village Forum – Bring together 1-2 reps from each group to a village meeting to try and combat groups needs and use resources that each group has for the benefit of the village. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ UDT & Church have already voiced support on this. ○ Uplawmoor Village Diary / Calendar – Suggestion from residents to have a central source where all group's, meetings and events in the village are calendarized. ○ ALL UCC MEMBERS TO LOOK OVER AND LET RL KNOW THOUGHTS • <u>Meeting with UDT</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Before the main UCC meeting we met with representatives from UDT.
