Report by the Chief Financial Officer

GENERAL FUND CAPITAL PROGRAMME

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is to monitor expenditure as at 20 February 2018 against the approved Capital Programme for 2017/18 and to recommend adjustments where necessary.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- The Cabinet is asked to:-
 - (a) note and approve the movements within the programme; and
 - (b) note the shortfall of £93,000 and that this will be managed and reported within the final accounts for the year.

INCOME MOVEMENTS

- 4. In response to the reduced level of expenditure anticipated during the current financial year the planned borrowing has been reduced by £735,000 and drawdown from the capital reserve reduced by £3.736m. These resources remain available to support the expenditure transferred to 2018/19.
- 5. Following a reassessment of capital receipts the income anticipated during the current financial year has been reduced by £710,000. These disposals remain in progress and it is anticipated this income will be received during subsequent financial years.

EXPENDITURE MOVEMENTS

6. The total estimated expenditure has reduced by £5.447m below the level reported to Cabinet on 30 November 2017. The main movements are as follows: -

Revised Project Timing - Reductions

i. Property – Schools

Major Maintenance – the contract for the window renewal scheme at Hazeldene Nursery (£80,000) has been awarded but as a result of the lead time for the delivery of the windows the main works have been rescheduled to the financial year 2018/19. The balance within provisional sums (£130,000) has been earmarked for roofing improvements at Isobel Mair School. The work specification will be investigated further and agreed by both staff within Property and Technical Services and the contractor to determine the most effective approach. While this approach will defer the works until 2018/19 it is considered necessary to ensure best value. As a consequence of both these projects the planned expenditure on schools major maintenance has been reduced by £210,000.

Early Learning and Childcare, Further Improvements - over recent years this budget has been used to deliver improvements of over £2.3m across the authority. In the interest of ensuring best value and to ensure the funding is used to address Education service priorities the expenditure balance of £245,000 will be deferred to 2018/19 and combined with budgets for Early Learning Childcare Expansion to 1,140 Hours and St Cadoc's PS Remodelling Pre-Five Provision. Planned expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £245,000.

Early Learning & Childcare Expansion to 1,140 Hours – the 2017/18 provision of £1.165m is being used to deliver phase one of the extended nursery provision at Busby PS and also to fund design development costs for other early years schemes to increase places across the authority in time for August 2020. While the works at Busby PS are now on site and the design process for future schemes is ongoing the planned expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £183,000. This will not impact on the delivery date of the schemes.

Security (CCTV) Expansion – the infrastructure required to support the CCTV activity across the Council will be renewed during 2018/19 and consequently the CCTV expansion has been deferred until this exercise is complete. Planned expenditure during the current financial year of £110,000 has been deferred to 2018/19.

ii. Property – Other

New Railway Station, Barrhead South – as reported to the meeting of the Council on 28 June 2017 it is considered prudent not to risk incurring further significant expenditure until formal approval of the STAG (Strategic Transport Analysis Guidance) report is received from Transport Scotland. While discussions with Transport Scotland on this issue are ongoing the formal approval remains outstanding. This project also involves access improvements at Balgraystone Road. The value of the returned tenders for this work exceeded the advertised value and in line with procurement regulations the scope and value of the works will be revised before the contract is retendered. As a consequence of both the above planned expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £1.415m in total, £545,000 as a result of the outstanding STAG approval and £870,000 as a result of the need to retender the Balgraystone Road works.

Eastwood Business Incubator and Innovation Centre & Employment Support Linked to Barrhead Foundry - the construction contract for the Eastwood business incubator has been awarded with a planned start date during March 2018, slightly later than originally estimated. Planned expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £70,000.

Thornliebank Depot Mechanical Extraction – this project is being combined with the Thornliebank Depot Roof Improvements (Property Maintenance) and managed as one contract. The returned tenders for this combined project exceeded the budgetary provision and the scope of the works was revised to identify cost savings with further budgetary provision of £64,000 also transferred from Property Maintenance provisional sums. As a consequence of the cost saving exercise the work has been delayed until 2018/19 and planned expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £138,000.

Cowan Park Changing Facilities – this project will be revised in light of the returned tenders significantly exceeding the budgetary provision. Planned expenditure of £300,000 has been deferred to 2018/19.

Vacant (surplus) Property/Demolitions – the purpose of this provision is to address structural issues or demolition work at vacant property which is life expired or is considered to present a risk to the wider community and requires immediate action. No significant work has been identified during the current financial year and planned expenditure has been reduced by £158,000.

Property Maintenance, CEEF/Salix – this is a self-sustaining energy efficiency fund which uses anticipated cost savings or repayments to fund further investment in subsequent years. Again to achieve best value, expenditure of £134,000 has been deferred to 2018/19 and combined with repayments due on 31 March 2018 will be used to fund further energy efficiency measures within the school estate.

Property Maintenance, Thornliebank Depot Roof Improvements – as outlined above this work has been deferred to 2018/19. Planned expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £134,000.

Property Maintenance, Community Facility Improvements – in order to minimise service disruption it was necessary to revise the content of the work scheduled for this financial year and planned expenditure has been reduced by £81,000.

Property Maintenance, Boiler Improvements – a review of the Council's estate has prioritised schools for boiler improvements. As a result the work is now scheduled to progress during the summer 2018 and the planned expenditure of £100,000 has been deferred to 2018/19.

iii. Open Spaces

Regeneration, Clarkston Town Centre Action and Traffic Management Improvements – an experimental traffic order is required before the main works can begin. Planned expenditure of £170.000 has been deferred to 2018/19.

Regeneration, Land and Property Acquisitions - a number of potential sites have been identified and are being progressed but are unlikely to conclude before the end of this financial year. Estimated expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £222,000.

iv. Roads

City Deal, Levern Valley Accessibility Project – this is a long term project. While the site investigations within the Aurs Road area are now complete the project remains at design stage and planned expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £70,000.

v. Council Wide - ICT

School Servers Storage – an external company has been conducting an exercise to scope the technology requirements for this project and the main works have been rescheduled to 2018/19. Planned expenditure during the current financial year has been reduced by £299,000.

Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards (PCI DSS) – the purpose of this provision is to fund any improvements required to meet the PCI DSS requirements which are identified during the annual PCI DSS audit. No improvements have been identified for this financial year but this is an ongoing issue and the budget of £65,000 has been deferred to 2018/19.

Wireless Local Area Network— a pilot exercise is planned before 31 March 2018 to test the technology at various sites within the authority including a library, community facility and sheltered housing complex. Subject to successful testing the technology will be rolled out more widely during 2018/19. Planned expenditure of £117,000 has been deferred to 2018/19.

Various Modernising/Digital projects – a number of projects are being progressed with departments which aim to make better use of digital technology and modernise how the Council works. While significant progress has been made on many of these projects the work will continue into future financial years as expenditure is dependent on external factors, competing resources and priorities. vi. Property – Culture & Leisure Trust

Neilston Leisure Centre Improvements & Barrhead Foundry Refurbishment – as approved by Cabinet on 30 November 2017 expenditure of £61,000 for improvements at Neilston Leisure Centre has been brought forward to the current financial year and the total provision for the Barrhead Foundry Refurbishment project increased by £185,000, with an increase of £125,000 in the current financial year.

COMMENT

7. The projected shortfall of £93,000 represents 0.4% of the resources available and is within manageable limits.



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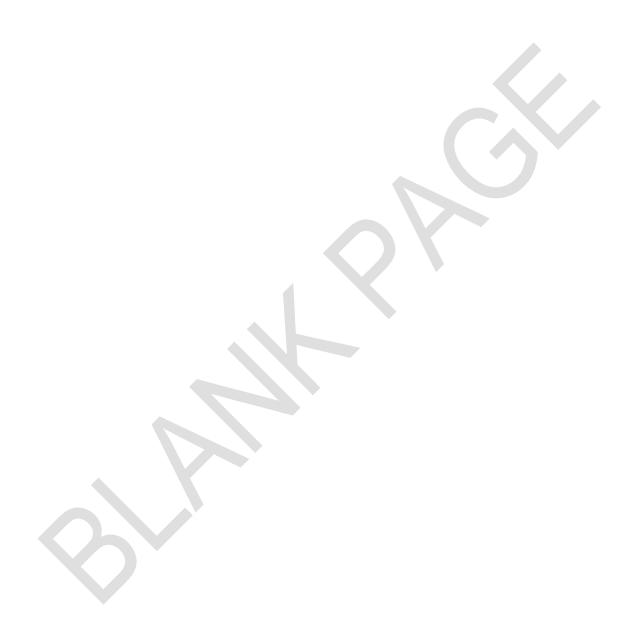
