

Oral Health - Dental Charges

- 3. Current NHS dental charges are part of the Statement of Dental remuneration (SDR). There are over 600 items of service that can be charged or claimed and full details of these can be found within the most recent official publication of the Statement of Dental Remuneration (June 2018), which can be found at: http://www.scottishdental.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/06/SDR-Amendment-No-138.pdf
- 4. An individual dentist will see a patient, discuss their treatment requirements and agree a treatment plan. They then complete a form called GP 17 and the patient is required to sign this to say they are accepting of this plan. This plan will outline the charges associated with this treatment.
- 5. There is a maximum charge for NHS dental treatment. At the moment this is £384.

- 6. Primary Care Mental Health performance data and improvement plan is in preparation and will be brought to the next Performance and Audit Committee.
- 7. We have requested further statistical information in relation to physiotherapy services. This will be included in the next physiotherapy performance update report.
