#### Preparing for Winter

- 3. The ongoing morning and evening service gap within community nursing is a board wide issue and no other areas within Greater Glasgow and Clyde have managed to address this fully. Some examples are:-
  - Renfrewshire bridges the gap 4.30 6.30 and based on goodwill gesture from staff
  - Inverclyde has an early bird service 6.30 8.30 and based on goodwill gesture from staff
- 4. All areas have tried various different pilots and the finding was generally there was not a huge demand for service at that time. All arrangements are and have been Monday to Friday only. There has been no implementation of any changes to service following the pilots within NHS GGC. There have been some local discussions about how we might bridge this gap within East Renfrewshire on a goodwill basis but this not been implemented as we currently have a number of staff vacancies.
- 5. Figures on direct access to care homes will be included in the post winter review report.
