NOTICE OF REVIEW – REVIEW 2017/03 – SUB-DIVISION OF FEU AND ERECTION OF ONE AND A HALF STOREY DETACHED DWELLINGHOUSE (PLANNING PERMISSION IN PRINCIPLE) AT 19 SANDRINGHAM AVENUE, NEWTON MEARNS (REF NO: 2016/0598/TP)

2421. The Local Review Body considered a report by the Deputy Chief Executive relative to a 'Notice of Review' submitted by Mr and Mrs Schlesinger against the decision taken by officers to refuse planning permission in principle in respect of the sub-division of feu and erection of a one and a half storey detached dwellinghouse at 19 Sandringham Avenue, Newton Mearns.

The decision had been made in accordance with the Council's Scheme of Delegation made in terms of Section 43A of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 as amended.

In accordance with the decision taken at the meeting on 10 August 2016, the Local Review Body had carried out an unaccompanied site inspection of the application site immediately prior to the meeting.
