Minutes of Annual General Meeting held on Tuesday the 10th July 2018

Welcome was extended to everyone in attendance.

Proposals Minutes of the previous AGM were proposed by ? and seconded ? – Carried. It was requested that minutes of the meeting be made available online prior to next meeting for those unable to attend. Agreed they would be uploaded to facebook and hopefully the website too.

Co-opted member David Williamson proposed by Duncan McIntyre seconded by David McAskill. Carried and welcomed. It was noted that we are not at full numbers yet in terms of members if anyone else interested in getting involved.

Police Report. PC David Nichols read the police report out. He advised those present that the police worked on priorities that the ERC community feed into Police Scotland by way of feedback and online submissions requests which is at the bottom of the police report. He pointed out how to do this on line - <https://www.surveymonkey.co.uk/r/CXH85XJ>

The police advised that if we want the local policing priorities to change, i.e. speeding it is up to us to do it via the survey monkey link.

Officers advised that any complaints regarding parking (ie. around the school at drop off and collection times) need to be reported to the council, as they can only deal with obstructions.

The floor was then given to Roddy ? From the Forestry Comission.

Issues regarding lack of parking near Carrot Farm were discussed, and various possible solutions were brought forward along with potential difficulties bearing in

mind the various stakeholders involved. Duncan McIntyre reported this has been a major topic of discussion at recent meeting with Jane Corrie of ERC Roads dept. Rod McCoull, one of the local farmers affected also explained the issue from his point of view.

Report from Jackson Carlaw MSP: this covered topics including local bus services, over-subscription of local schools, Gladman proposals, state of unadopted parts of Bonnyton Drive, local post office provision, the Beer Festival and Brexit. Mr Carlaw commended the work of EWCC thus far. Grateful for our re-establishment as he lives in Waterfoot.

Floor opened to attendees for any other issues: land at the top of Brackenrig, more bins and more frequent collections was discussed.

Meeting with Jane Corrie from Roads Dept: Not many positive answers, ERC not keen on 20mph zone. Polnoon estate discussed. Zebra crossings, Bellecraig roundabout, 1 way system at shops. School issues – we should liaise with PTA.

Ian MacDonald from Eaglesham Fayre committee will be coming to next meeting.
