A. Convery raised an issue about flooding in Aurs road from the Farm which has affected the Bungalows. Unfortunately this is out of control of the Community Council,

Dubs Rd which is a public access road, is being blocked off by the Farmer who maintains it's a no access road.

There is no vehicle access; pedestrians will have a right to access along the track as far as the small bridge at the end of Cowan Park. There is also a small gate adjacent to Cowan Park at this point. There is also a new gate across Dubs Road which is legitimate because it provides a side access point for pedestrians to pass.
