Drug Dealing & Drug Use

Drunk and Disorderly Behaviour

Calls relating to disturbance or public nuisance in Busby continue to remain at very low levels.

On the 2nd September a complaint was received from staff at a business premises in Main Street Busby, relating to eggs being thrown from a car at the premises. About 8.15pm on the 18th September a "Road Rage" incident occurred on Main St. Busby, whereby a male cyclist is alleged to have been verbally abused by the driver of a Red car.
