3. Police Scotland Report

- MI Crime rates remain low in Clarkston. Notable crimes include theft of bikes in Sunnybank Grove and another street. Also a 21 year old make was found in possession of cannabis on Eastwood Mains Road. It has also been requested if we can share the Police Scotland summer campaign on Facebook. There was incident at Pollok Park after a youth passed away from drowning. It would be appreciated if the community council could share Police Scotland social media messages.
- 4. Matters for Discussion

Clarkston Community and Coronavirus Impact – Recovery, Community Impact and CCC Role

- AD Created social distancing materials for businesses, happy to share with others. Developed training platform for businesses to be compliant with Covid regulations. Also remote audits to see if measures are in place, also businesses are certified and receive sneeze shields. Supporting town centre approach to reopening. There is a map of the town and how to queue safely. Working alongside East Renfrewshire Council and Business Gateway. ERC have also developed social distancing measures for businesses. After speaking with businesses, busier than last year. Engagement with businesses has been difficult as mainly online or over email. Also aware car park work has began but not aware of the new timescales for work. Finally working on contingency plan if the lockdown is to return.
- TS Working with Voluntary Action ER on the Wee Chat and Station Planters group. Looking to promote the work of the Spaces for People work by ERC and Sustrans and gather feedback. The group has paused due to the lockdown but plans to resume from the 15th July.

Social Media/Community Communications Update

- o JF Engagement has been difficult on social media.
- RN Still need more people to join the Facebook Group. There has been a meeting by the sub group for social media and JF did great work with photo competition. Need to also develop original content as sharing other information currently.
- AD is happy to promote over I Love Clarkston Group and Page, also need to do things that are not usually discussed on social media like the Get to Know Your Neighbour Campaign.

• BD – Promote local groups, funding and support to local groups.

Survey Response Update and next steps

 MI – There has been 303 survey responses as of todays meeting date. 46% of responses are from Clarkston. The issues we asked for priority scoring are listed as followed in priority order from highest to lowest from the survey responses. Issues – 1.Town Centre Amenities, 2.Car Parking, 3.Environment Including recycling, 4.Crime /antisocial behaviour and roads/crossing traffic jointly, 5. Public transport, 6. Public Spaces for activities and events, 7.Litter, 8.Health and Wellbeing.

- RN How long can we keep survey open and where else can it be shared or engaged? The survey did have slow start but need to increase engagement.
- BD We have focused on litter, could also look at services and activities for young people.
- JF Services for young people also mentioned in further comments by survey respondents. Perhaps a youth committee could be setup, they could access funding and lead with our support.
- MI There is East Renfrewshire Youth Forum.
- CDM Can contact the ERY Forum and ask if they could become more involved in Clarkston.
- AD Could also use the engagement to lead a Get to Know Your Neighbour Campaign to help towards gathering community spirit and pride in your own street.
- MI ACTION to focus on survey as a main item on next meeting agenda.

Cycling Scotland Pilot

o GCox spoke with Veloworld, their funding for lessons has stopped but can do personal lessons for a fee. They can do a video for £450, filming about cycling in Clarkston. Keith Fergus contacted to share there is funding for further pilots. Initially was for 10 families but now extended for more and beyond Clarkston. The feedback has been excellent. Hope to build confidence of people to keep cycling and will need to think about cycling infrastructure in East Renfrewshire.

Wildflowers Scheme

 Packets were distributed but not many photos have been sent back. RN – sent photos of patch of grass at Varder Avenue of flowers growing. GCox will send in photos too. BD dispersed seeds at end of Varder Avenue and top of Cathkin Drive. CDM has also planted seeds and will take pictures. ACTION - collate photos and request on original Facebook post.

Litter Pick

o RN – Neal had raised posts about litter behind Williamwood High School and need for community pick. Could we do a join litter pick in this area with Busby Community Council? KO – Maybe too soon in terms of Covid-19 guidance. Will look at Roadmap for more clarity. RN – Best to wait til safer to organise and can contact Busby CC when safe to do so. AD – Happy to get involved and have picking equipment. Also noted there was a community litter picks by local community council in East Ayrshire. CDM -Explore if anyway to engage with the perpertrators of littering and look at causes and try to send a message. How do we prevent? Need to look at cause?

New Initiatives – Move to next meeting due to time.

5. Diversity ER Meeting on Tackling Racism and Discrimination in East Renfrewshire

MI attended meeting as has been a member of the forum since 2003. Diversity ER was setup by Black and Minority Ethnic(BME)community members who attended the East Renfrewshire Council Minority Ethnic Forum. The meeting was attended by council officers, councillors, MP and MSP, East Renfrewshire Faith Forum as well as BME community members. The meeting heard about research collated by Diversity ER which included examples of racism occurring in education, business, community and sport. We heard that many respondees noted a fear of reporting to both police and council for fear of retaliation from council services etc. The meeting concluded the need to work together to improve the situation for BME people in East Renfrewshire while also rooting out racism from our schools workplaces and streets.

6. Planning

- Nothing specific. Noted there is another mast application near Williamwood Golf Club.
- 7. <u>Licensing</u> No licensing applications for Clarkston. CK has made contact with the Officer Christine McAuley and there will be a meeting for Licensing for 10th July.
- 8. <u>Treasurers Report</u> The bank account total is £1638.68. There has been no activity.

10.<u>AOCB</u>

- KO Posted about plastic free July and happy to support CCC to share this message. Still lobbying about climate challenge. Also there is a Busby and Clarkston local Horticultural Society that CCC could connect to locally. They have events including flower shows. Still not enough people in local area wearing masks or face coverings.
- AD Businesses do not want to ask people to wear masks as they do not want that responsibility. Businesses are feeling uncomfortable.
- RN Future CCC meetings to start from 7pm online. Also can offer tabards and litter pick equipment to individuals who want to litter pick due to the social distancing and guidelines.
- AD Renewal Ballot extended to March 2021 by Scottish Government. Still happy for CCC to be on the Board of Clarkston BID. May struggle to attend full CCC meeting if starting at 7pm but will join during meeting.
- BD Currently compiling list of local organisations and groups. If anyone has any further information please send to Brian. AD is happy to share list Clarkston BID with BD.
