

### Whitelee Windfarm Event Request Form

This form is for groups, charities and organisations that wish to use Whitelee Windfarm for hosting of an event. Please note the application will be subject to review by land managers before permission is provisionally granted after which time further planning and documentation may be required. Completion of the application form will not necessarily result in approval of the event.

Please be advised that specialist event insurance may be required for some events - please consider this during your planning.

The Whitelee Countryside Ranger Service are here to help you with planning your event, site knowledge and on the day if required – please do not hesitate to contact them.

The following notes are provided to aid you in completing the 'Whitelee Event Request Form' in full. Ensure that you have filled out all sections relevant to your proposed event and have double checked the form before sending it in as missing information could result in delays to a decision.

Due to the high volume of requests that can be received and the time it takes to assess each one, allow up to 6 weeks for a reply. Please also be prepared to come in to discuss your event request in detail if required. You may also be asked to provide further detail in the form of an event management plan and associated documents.

Planning any event can require a substantial time input. Please note the following advisory guidelines for timescales to prepare your application and lodge it well in advance of your planned event date. These are guidelines only and good preparation and planning by the event organiser can significantly reduce this time:

The following are specific guidance notes to refer to when filling out your application

- 1 Is this date fixed or flexible? Please provide a couple of alternative dates if possible?
- <sup>2</sup> Please include details of set-up and clear-up time at the start and finish so that the outcome is a time including ALL factors.
- <sup>3</sup> Please give an educated 'estimate' including all staff and volunteers for your planned event.
- <sup>4</sup> Please note that the following activities and events cannot be hosted within the windfarm under any circumstances. This is unfortunately due to health and safety concerns, operational restrictions and conflict with the Scottish Outdoor Access Code.

#### List of events that cannot be hosted:


- Fireworks displays / Bonfire events
- Balloon releases
- Kite, model aircraft, glider, hang-glider, parasailing, parachuting, hot-air ballooning (or any other 'flying' machine/apparatus) events
- Motorsport events
- Motorised water sports
- <sup>5</sup> Please note that 'vehicle access' does not mean access to car parking facilities, but refers to access to areas of the windfarm normally excluded to vehicle traffic, except works vehicles.
- <sup>6</sup> By additional facilities this means any additional equipment or materials you need to bring in for the purpose of your event. For example marquee or tents, barriers, power generation equipment, PA equipment etc.


