CPP Self-Assessment

- A robust self-assessment was completed in summer 2015 using the Improvement Service Model.
- Overall, East Renfrewshire CPP has a positive story to tell.
- The self-assessment is strong preparation for any future Best Value Audit.
- Prioritised areas for improvement should be integrated within current improvement approaches and the implementation of the Community Empowerment Act.
- The PAR will monitor progress in the improvement areas

Areas for Improvement

Agreed Improvement Areas:

1. Better awareness within the partnership and at community level about ongoing partnership working including more accessible public performance information.
2. Build on the Model for Improvement work in the five SOA areas.
3. Work to implement the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act including locality based planning and an area forum review.
