Outcome 2

By 2018 East Renfrewshire will be the highest performing council area in participation and engagement rates of adult residents in sporting and cultural activities.

<u>Completed tests of change</u>: women's ethnic minority swimming and S3+ girls dance programme

<u>Current tests of change</u>: Gymnastics Club for S3+ girls at Barrhead High

<u>Planned tests of change</u>: expansion of teaching options for women's ethnic minority swimming group



Outcome 3

We will increase the number of individuals accessing our services, and who achieve a positive sustained outcome, by 60% by 2020.

<u>Completed tests of change</u>: employability event, targeted promotion of the modern apprentice scheme, data sharing project

<u>Current tests of change</u>: social media project with partners, promotion of Work EastRen training course

Planned tests of change: marketing and rebranding of Work EastRen



Outcome 4

In order to improve public safety, we will reduce the levels of serious and common assaults by 15% by 2017.

<u>Completed tests of change</u>: response to noise calls project – now business as usual

Current tests of change: violence against women project with Women's Aid

Planned tests of change: gardening project for ex-offenders



Focus for 2016-17

- Work on the three priority stretch aims will continue during 2016-17.
- The PAR will continue to oversee outcome improvement work under the SOA 2/3/4 stretch aims and monitor progress towards the stretch aims.
- The Model for Improvement approach and stretch aims will be a key consideration in the development of the Local Outcome Improvement Plan and locality plans.
