NOTICE OF REVIEW – REVIEW 2016/01 – ERECTION OF WALL WITH TIMBER FENCE INSETS AT FRONT AND SIDE (IN RETROSPECT) AT 39 STOBS DRIVE, BARRHEAD (REF NO 2015/0658/TP)

1945. The Local Review Body considered a report by the Deputy Chief Executive, relative to a 'Notice of Review' submitted by Mr Mark Crookshank against the decision taken by officers to refuse planning permission in respect of the erection of a wall with timber fence insets at front and side (in retrospect) at 39 Stobs Drive, Barrhead.

The decision had been made in accordance with the Council's Scheme of Delegation made in terms of Section 43A of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 as amended.

In accordance with the decision taken at the meeting on 4 November 2015, the Local Review Body had carried out an unaccompanied site inspection of the application site on 7 March 2016.
