Clinical Governance

Bonnyton House

- 4. Letters have been sent to Bonnyton residents' families/carers as well as day service users advising them of the decision to sell Bonnyton House as a going concern. A meeting for families has been arranged on 12th November to update families on progress.
- 5. Managers met staff at Bonnyton immediately after the last IJB meeting. Letters have also been sent to staff confirming the decision of the IJB and further letters sent telling each staff member whether they will be part of a TUPE transfer. Individual meetings with managers and HR staff have been arranged for any staff member who wants one.
- 6. Meeting has taken place with representatives from Grant Thornton to begin the process of marketing the residential service. Meeting arranged with HSCP managers, Grant Thornton and Council Legal Services to agree process and timescales.

7. The Strategic Planning Group held a workshop on Friday 30th October, which tested outcome improvement diagrams as an approach to identifying priorities and key performance indicators.
