ERECTION OF ONE AND A HALF STOREY REAR EXTENSION FORMING GABLE END WITH ASSOCIATED RAISING OF RIDGE HEIGHT AND SINGLE STOREY EXTENSION AT 27 LAWRENCE AVENUE, GIFFNOCK

#### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1. The purpose of the report is to present the information currently available to allow a review of the decision taken by officers, in terms of the Scheme of Delegation made in terms of Section 43A of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 as amended by the Planning etc (Scotland) Act 2006 in respect of the application detailed below.

#### **DETAILS OF APPLICATION**

**2.** Application type: Full Planning Permission (Ref No:- 2015/0452/TP).

Applicant: Mr and Mrs MacMillan

Proposal: Erection of one and a half storey rear extension forming gable

end with associated raising of ridge height and single storey

extension

Location: 27 Lawrence Avenue, Giffnock.

Council Area/Ward: Giffnock and Thornliebank (Ward 3).

#### **REASON FOR REQUESTING REVIEW**

**3.** The applicants have requested a review on the grounds that the Council's appointed officer refused the application.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 4. The Local Review Body is asked to:-
  - (a) consider whether it has sufficient information to allow it to proceed to determine the review without further procedure and, if so, that:-
    - (i) it proceeds to determine whether the decision taken in respect of the application under review should be upheld, reversed or varied; and
    - (ii) in the event that the decision is reversed or varied, the reasons and the detailed conditions to be attached to the decision letter are agreed.

- (b) In the event that further procedure is required to allow it to determine the review, consider:-
  - (i) what further information is required, which parties are to be asked to provide the information and the date by which this is to be provided; and/or;
  - (ii) what procedure or combination of procedures are to be followed in determining the review.

#### **BACKGROUND**

- 5. At the meeting of the Council on 29 April 2009, consideration was given to a report by the Director of Environment seeking the adoption of a new Scheme of Delegation in terms of the new Section 43A of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, subject to approval of the scheme by Scottish Ministers.
- 6. The report provided details of the new hierarchy of developments that took effect from 6 April 2009 explaining that the Scheme of Delegation related to those applications within the "local development" category as set out in the Town and Country Planning (Hierarchy of Development) (Scotland) Regulations 2009, but would in future be determined by an "appointed officer". In the Council's case this would be either the Director of Environment or the Head of Roads, Planning and Transportation Service now designated the Head of Environment (Planning, Property and Regeneration).
- 7. The report highlighted that historically appeals against planning decisions were dealt with by Scottish Ministers. However, following the introduction of the new planning provisions with came into effect on 3 August 2009 all appeals against decisions made in respect of local developments under delegated powers would be heard by a Local Review Body. The Local Review Body would also deal with cases where the appointed officer had failed to determine an application within two months from the date it was lodged.

#### NOTICE OF REVIEW - STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR REQUIRING THE REVIEW

- **8.** The applicants in submitting their review have stated the reasons for requiring the review of the determination of their application. A copy of the applicants' Notice of Review and Statement of Reasons is attached as Appendix 4.
- **9.** The applicants are entitled to state a preference for the procedure (or combination of procedures) to be followed by the Local Review Body in the determination of the review and have indicated that their stated preferences are a site inspection and assessment of review documents only, with no further procedure.
- **10.** The Local Review Body is not bound to accede to the applicants' request as to how it will determine the review and will itself decide what procedure will be used in this regard.

#### INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO ALLOW REVIEW OF APPLICATION

11. Section 43B of the Planning etc (Scotland) Act 2006 restricts the ability of parties to introduce new material at the review stage. The Local Review Body is advised that the focus of the review should, therefore, be on the material which was before the officer who dealt with the application under the Scheme of Delegation.

#### **SUPPORTING REPORTS:**

No reports have been submitted for consideration as part of this application.

#### ASSESSMENT:

The application site comprises a detached hipped roofed bungalow with front and rear dormer windows and its curtilage and lies within an established residential area. The side and rear boundaries are characterised by established planting.

Planning permission is sought for the erection of a one and a half storey rear extension forming a gable end, raising of the ridge height and for the erection of a single storey side extension. The proposed extension measures 4 metres deep from the rear of the existing dwelling and would lie 1 metre from the rear boundary at its closest point. The ridge is proposed to be raised by 0.5 metres.

The proposed rear extension with its large rear gable wall is considered to be of a design and form markedly different from that of the existing hipped roofed bungalow. As such, the proposed extension cannot be considered to be in keeping with the existing dwelling in terms of its character, form and design. The additional mass created by the proposed extension is considered to dominate and overwhelm the existing dwelling. Furthermore, the proposal would result in a significant degree of overlooking towards number 24 Bromley Drive from a proposed rear facing first floor bedroom window. This would significantly compromise the amenity of the residents of the dwelling to the rear as the rear first floor window would lie between 4 and 6.5 metres from the rear boundary.

The proposal is therefore contrary to Policies D1 and D14 of the adopted Local Development Plan. Policy D1 provides that, in all development, the amenity of neighbouring properties should not be unreasonably adversely affected by restricting their privacy and Policy D14 requires that extensions to dwellings should complement the existing character in terms of form and style. Policy D14 is supported the Supplementary Planning Guidance: Householder Design Guide (SPG). The SPG states that extensions to the rear of bungalows should have a roof design to match that of the existing dwelling as well as having a ridge line below that of the existing dwelling. As there are no material considerations that outweigh the above policy considerations, it is recommended that the application be refused.

**RECOMMENDATION: Refuse**

- The development is contrary to Policies D1 and D14 of the adopted East Renfrewshire Local Development Plan as: i) the proposal would give rise to an unacceptable degree of overlooking towards the property to the rear; and ii) the proposed one and a half storey rear extension and gable end would not be in keeping with the character of the existing dwelling in terms of its form and design and would dominate and overwhelm its original form and character.

Policy D1

Detailed Guidance for all Development

Proposals for development should be well designed, sympathetic to the local area and demonstrate that the following criteria have been considered, and, where appropriate, met. In some cases, where the criteria have not been met, a written justification will be required to assist with assessment.

- 1. The development should not result in a significant loss of character or amenity to the surrounding area;
- 2. The proposal should be of a size, scale, massing and density that is in keeping with the buildings in the locality and should respect local architecture, building form, design, and materials:
- 3. The amenity of neighbouring properties should not be adversely affected by unreasonably restricting their sunlight or privacy. Additional guidance on this issue is available in the Daylight and Sunlight Design Guide Supplementary Planning Guidance;
- 4. The development should not impact adversely on landscape character or the green network, involve a significant loss of trees or other important landscape, greenspace or biodiversity features:
- 5. Developments should incorporate green infrastructure including access, landscaping, greenspace, water management and Sustainable Urban Drainage Systems at the outset of the design process. Where appropriate, new tree or shrub planting should be incorporated using native species. The physical area of any development covered by impermeable surfaces should be kept to a minimum to assist with flood risk management. Further guidance is contained within the Green Network and Environmental Management Supplementary Planning Guidance;
- 6. Development should create safe and secure environments that reduce the scope for anti-social behaviour and fear of crime;
- 7. Developments must be designed to meet disability needs and include provision for disabled access within public areas;
- 8. The Council will not accept 'backland' development, that is, development without a road frontage;
- 9. Parking and access requirements of the Council should be met in all development and appropriate mitigation measures should be introduced to minimise the impact of new development. Development should take account of the principles set out in 'Designing Streets':
- 10. Development should minimise the extent of light pollution caused by street and communal lighting and any floodlighting associated with the development;
- 11. Developments should include provision for the recycling, storage, collection and composting of waste materials:
- 12. Where possible, all waste material arising from construction of the development should be retained on-site for use as part of the new development;
- 13. Where applicable, new development should take into account the legacy of former mining activity;
- 14. Development should enhance the opportunity for and access to sustainable transportation, including provision for bus infrastructure, and particularly walking and cycle opportunities including cycle parking and provision of facilities such as showers/lockers, all where appropriate. The Council will not support development on railways solums or other development that would remove opportunities to enhance pedestrian and cycle access unless mitigation measures have been demonstrated;
- 15. The Council requires the submission of a design statement for national and major developments. Design statements must also be submitted in cases where a local development relates to a site within a conservation area or Category A listed building in line with Planning Advice Note 68: Design Statements.

16. Where applicable, developers should explore opportunities for the provision of digital infrastructure to new homes and business premises as an integral part of development.

#### Policy D14

Extensions to Existing Buildings and Erection of Outbuildings and Garages Any extensions must complement the existing character of the property, particularly in terms of style, form and materials.

The size, scale and height of any development must be appropriate to the existing building. In most circumstances, pitched roofs utilising slates or tiles to match the existing house will be the appropriate roof type. Alternatives, such as flat roofs or green roofs, will be considered on a site specific basis.

Side extensions should not create an unbroken or terraced appearance.

The development should avoid over-development of the site by major loss of existing garden space.

Dormer windows should not in general dominate the existing roof, nor rise above or break the existing ridgeline or hip of the roof, and should be finished in materials to match existing roof finishes.

The above are broad requirements and these are further defined in the Householder Design Guide Supplementary Planning Guidance.

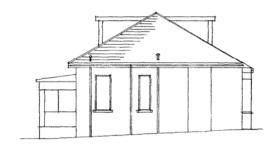

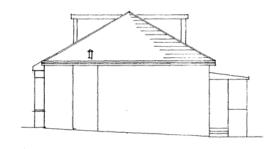

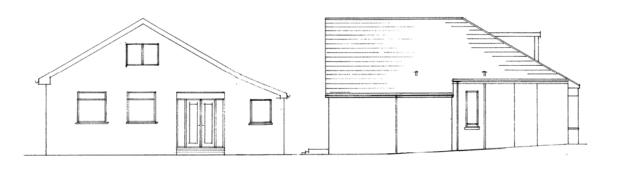

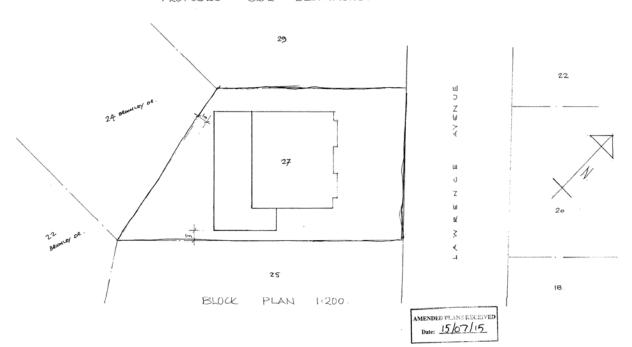


PROPOSED REAR ELEVATION.

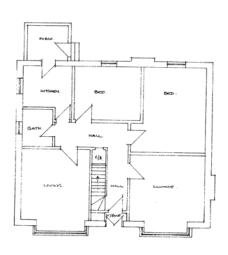

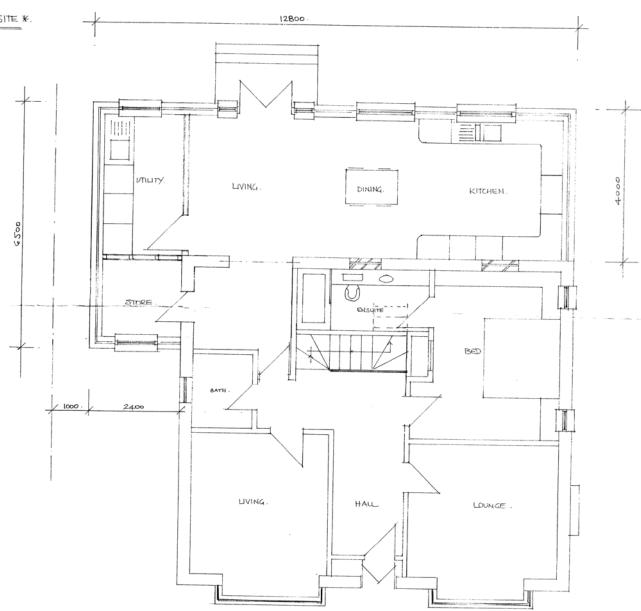




EXISTING G.F. PLAN.

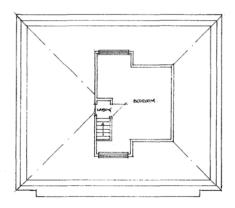

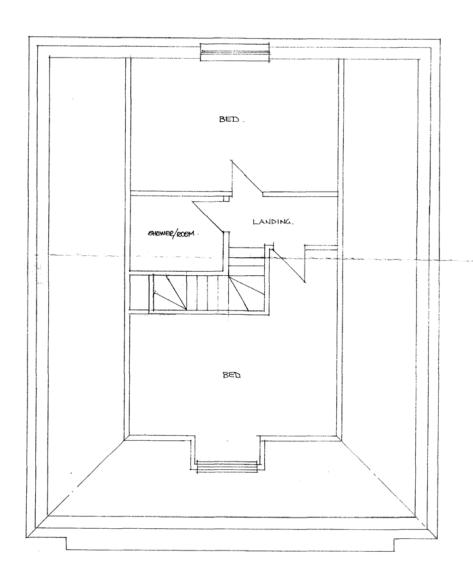


EXISTING IST FLOOR PLAN.
